

## Rewards for Wellness 2018–2019 Annual Preventive Exam

As part of Rewards for Wellness 2018–2019, complete an annual preventive exam between January 1, 2018–December 31, 2018 and earn \$100 in co-share credit\*

## **Qualifying preventive exams**

- Annual physical exam
- Annual gynecological exam
- Cervical cancer screening (annual pap smear)
- · Basic metabolic panel
- Colonoscopy
- Mammogram
- · Prenatal obstetrical exam



## How to complete\*\*

- If you have already had a preventive exam in 2018 that was processed through the UnitedHealthcare claims system, you have already completed this activity. If not, obtain at least one of the qualifying preventive exams between **January 1**, 2018–December 31, 2018 in order to earn the \$100 co-share credit.
- UnitedHealthcare automatically tracks your participation through your claims activity.
